Conditions for Non-commercial Traders:

1. Trading includes displaying, demonstrating, taking orders, selling or giving away items.
2. Trading may only involve items of an electrical, electronic or associated nature, unless prior permission is obtained from the Organising Committee.
3. Traders are expected to comply with their obligations to correctly describe all goods as required under Fair Trading or any other relevant legislation or regulations.
4. Allocation of trading space including determination of category (car boot, trailer or station wagon) is the decision of the Organising Committee and those it delegates to that task. Space and location will be provided where possible to meet the needs of a trader, however the final decision rests with the Organising Committee.
5. Traders should be set up and ready to trade by 9.45am. Access to the site will be available from 7am. Vehicles are expected to be unloaded and then parked as directed in the main car park outside the racecourse by 9.45am or as directed, and not permitted to be part of trading activities unless pre-arranged or a car boot sale.
6. If required Traders are responsible for insuring their displays and goods against any loss or risk. The Organising Committee accepts no liability whatsoever for loss, theft, damage by fire, accident or any other cause.
7. All adults are required to pay the ticketed admission cost of \$10 and tickets must be produced on request as proof of payment. Non-commercial trade space pricing includes one entry admission. *Where set-up assistance is provided by someone who does not stay during the RadioFest they may get a full ticket refund on their departure before 10am.*
8. Excessive noise, any other emissions that cause disturbance to the orderly conduct of trading and or other activities may result in a direction to cease or switch off the source.
9. The only advertising or other amplified announcements permitted are those made by the announcer assigned by the Organising Committee. Traders may provide brief announcements as legible text, preferably printed. The decision on whether or not an announcement will be made, and/or its timing, is at the discretion of the announcer or the organising committee.
10. No auctions, raffles or the like are permitted unless by prior arrangement with the organising committee. If these are agreed the trader must take responsibility for their conduct in compliance with any relevant legislation or licensing requirements.
